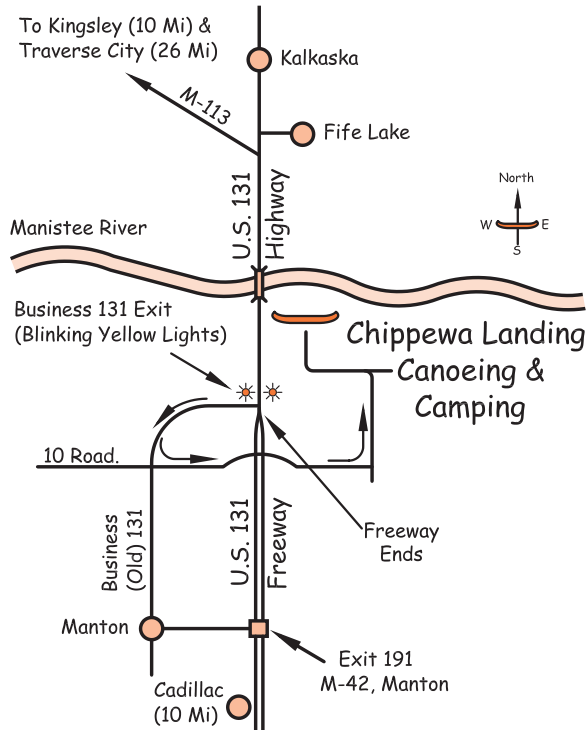


You don't need experience to canoe the Manistee. There are no waves or rapids. You can just let the current carry you downstream.

For an afternoon picnic trip, an adventurous overnight campout to remember, or an extended exploration of the famous Manistee River water shed, you will enjoy a relaxing float downstream to Chippewa Landing. No appointment schedule to worry about ... stop and fish, swim, or picnic to suit your whim. Your car will be waiting for you at Chippewa Landing.



The Manistee River remains relatively unsettled for mile after mile; its banks are unspoiled wilderness with deer, beaver, ducks and other wildlife. Pure water springs and creeks, camping and picnic sites.

For years, Chippewa Landing's friendly service, natural setting and top equipment have worked to provide a unique and valuable canoeing experience at a reasonable cost.

The most unspoiled natural camping river in the Lower Peninsula, the Manistee River has become known as the place to come for superior canoe-camping in a rougher, more isolated area.

Please respect the river, and the people on the river. Refrain from playing loud music, making loud noises, and leaving any trash, especially empty cans behind. Operating any water craft while intoxicated is illegal in Michigan, and can be dangerous to yourself and others. The Manistee River doesn't require special permits or have any special regulations, but it will take your cooperation to keep it that way.

What are we doing for our environment?

- We will aid groups seriously interested in policing the river for litter.
- Our employees are paid to be litter-conscious, but they can't do it alone.

What can you do?

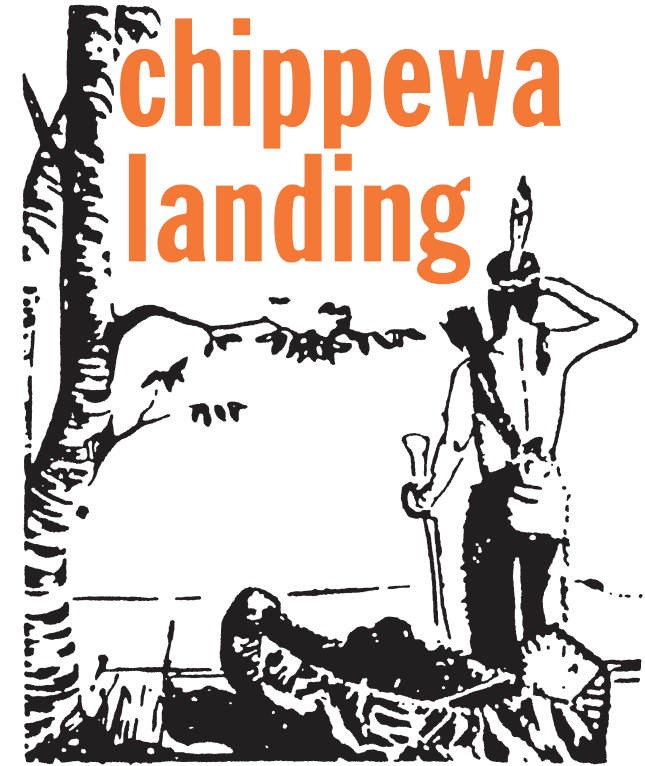
Please,

- Don't bring glass beverage bottles.
- Don't bring aluminum foil, cans, throw-away beverage containers, individually wrapped penny candies and Styrofoam coolers.
- Don't bury your trash.
- Don't peel birch bark.
- Don't use live saplings, other than Poplar, for tent poles, hot dog sticks, etc.

Please,

- Do bring returnable beverage containers and bio degradable wrappers and containers.
- Do pack all your gear in floatable containers.
- Do use only dead and fallen wood for campfires.
- Do pitch in and pick up after others.

Privacy and spaciousness with water, tables, shelters, firewood and privies provided in separate areas to allow maximum convenience for groups and family camping.

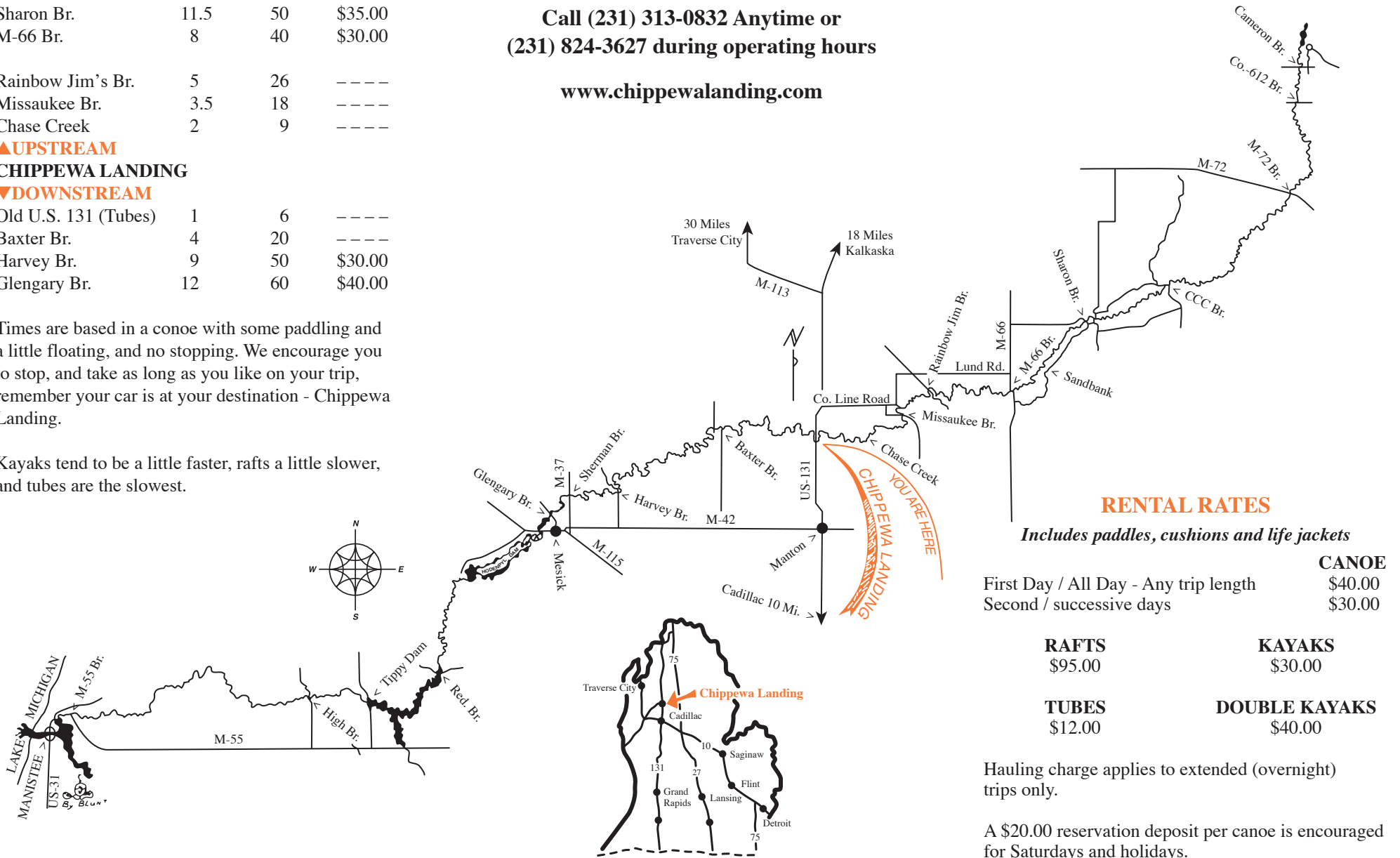
